
Understanding Moroccan Zellige

The Zellige tile collection from Villa Lagoon Tile brings an imperfect charm to any project. Unlike machined tile, these exquisite Zellige and Bejmat tiles are crafted entirely by hand in a time-honored method of tile-making designed to celebrate the natural beauty of the clay.



The art and craft of tile making in Morocco dates back to the 12th century and has been passed down through generations by master craftsmen called maâlems. The handmade nature of zellige tiles means that each tile is unique, with slight variations in color, texture, and shape. The process is time-consuming and requires skilled artisans with a deep understanding of the craft. As a result, zellige tiles have a distinct and timeless aesthetic that reflects the rich cultural heritage of Morocco.




